#### Tennessee Twist

(on an Old Fashioned)

- 1 slice of blood orange
- 1 Luxardo cherry with a bit of the Maraschio cherry juice/liquor
- 3 dashes of spiced cherry bitters by Woodford
- 1.5 ounces of homemade blood orange single syrup (half 100 percent blood orange purée, which you can find in select store or on Amazon, and half simple syrupl
- 2 ounces Jack Daniel's single barrel nye

Muddle blood orange and cherry with bittel and simple syrup. Fill glass with ice and pull whiskey. Shake and top with a splash of splash water. Garnish with a cherry and orange flat

It also doubles as a wood-fired grill, and you can use the converter package to turn it into a smoker or pizza oven.
